- ASIA is not immune to these requirements, with Global companies leading the charge


## Increase in Customer expectations

## Meeting increasing requirements to track and report travel impacts


- Increased expectations for TMCs to support customers to track and report on:



#### Fare Class Usage by Flight Duration














